Farmland Bankruptcy Continues

The latest press release of September 3 announced Farmlands intent to sell the fertilizer business. The assets are the primary component of Farmland's Crop Production division, which had sales of \$745 million in fiscal 2001.

Farmland owns seven nitrogen fertilizer manufacturing facilities in five states. It also owns 19 fertilizer distribution terminals throughout the U.S. The Crop Production

division employs 531 administrative and production workers.

Farmland has elected to focus on growing and improving Farmland Foods and the Farmland brand.

This latest decision by their 21-member board will be reviewed by the court-appointed committees overseeing Farmland's reorganization.
